

2007Alabama Outstanding Youth Ham of the Year Award

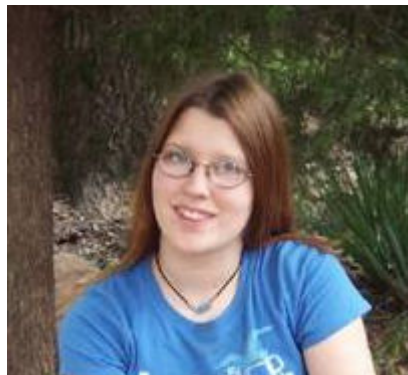
